Module 1: Work Orientation

 organisation, and a specific workplace

- Use mathematics to investigate and monitor the financial aspects of personal and community life
- Work with a range of patterns and functions and solve problems

- Administer contracts for a selected new venture

Module 5: Finances of a New Venture

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- Determine financial requirements of a new venture
- Identify the composition of a selected new venture's industry/sector procurement systems
- · Manage finances for a new venture
- Produce a business plan for a new venture
- Prepare and process documents for financial and banking processes
